

God is never late!

Today there are a lot of you who sit here who are hurting and desperate for a manifestation of God's power and His glory. Some of you feel that the Great and Noble God whom we serve has left you. Some of you feel that He has forgotten about you and more importantly, you feel He is late and the perfect opportunity for Him to meet (or accommodate) your need has now passed.

- ◆ Therefore, God must be passed due or late because He has failed to answer my prayer.
- ◆ God must be late because He has not healed my body.
- ◆ God must be late because I have been in the same predicament for almost 10 years now.
- ◆ God must be late because I still don't have any money to pay my bills.
- ◆ God must be late because I'm still lonely, broke, depressed, confused, hurt, tired, sick, down & out, no place to go, no mate, no person to talk to, no family to call on and no peace of mind.
- ◆ Thus you feel that God is just too late.

I got news for everybody God isn't late. He hasn't forgot, He hasn't left and He's not even like man that He can even commit the mistake of being late. **Today I tell you that it is impossible for God to be late. My Jesus, He, who is the same yesterday, today, and forever more, can pull yesterday's promises and yesterday's requests into today's manifested promises. My people God can heal all pains, sicknesses, and hurts which are the results of things that took place in your past, simply by going into your past and fixing what was in your past causing today's pain hurt. Yes God will go into the past and fix the past so that today's pain will be changed into today's healing. [Yes today's bondage will be change into today's deliverance (sadness into happiness, frustration into joy, confusion into clarity, sickness into healing).]**

Some of the primary reasons as to why we feel God is late are:

- ◆ **We are off schedule. Our timing is not God's timing.** The time that is on our watch does not match the time that is on God's watch. Simply put, we are not in the will of God concerning some things. Therefore as a result of not being in the will of God, we have no clue as to what time it actually is in God's zone or His frame of reference. **For example, if I am used to watching my favorite show at 7pm on the East Coast at Eastern standard time and then I now moved to the West Coast where the time zone is different and then turn on the TV expecting to see my favorite show at 7, there is going to be a problem. Either I'm going to think that my clock is wrong, the TV station cancel the show, or they are late in showing the show tonight. When in reality, the truth of the matter is that because I am in a different time zone the show comes on at a different time than what I am used to seeing. The same is true with God, many of**



us have been expecting things to show up in our lives and they have yet to show up because we have change time zones. We have left God's time zone (His perfect will) and went into our own time zone. Therefore we have no clue as to when or what time the promise of God will manifest in our life, all because we are off schedule (outside of God's will).

- ◆ Another reason as to why we feel that God is late is that we have misunderstandings and a lack of communication with God. Lack of communication can only take place when we fail to pray. A weak prayer life will constitute a misunderstanding on your part and will bring about ignorance to God's timing and His plans and purposes for your life. It is impossible for you to know when God is going to move or when God is going to bring the vision or promise to past if you don't take the time to get in His zone and discover His plans. If you ever discover God's plans you would find out that it is impossible for Him to be late, you would even further realize some of the times and places that God has scheduled Himself to move mightily in your life.
- ◆ The final reason as to why we feel that God is late is that we haven't learned how to wait on God. Waiting on God doesn't mean to just sit down on your behind and remain there until something occurs or happens. My friend it goes deeper than that, waiting on God is all about your service and ministry to God. You are God's earthly waiter and He is your divine customer. It is your job to prepare His table so that He may be seated, give Him something to eat and drink, and ask if there is anything else that He will be needing this service. Make sure that God is satisfied with your service. Be obedient to His commands and sayings. Know that if God is satisfied with your service [which is comparable to your waiting on Him] He is going to pay his bill [which is your need at the time] and tip you greatly, if of course, your service is excellent. Remember that the quality of your service determines the quantity and quality of your tip. Can you imagine what it must feel like to be tipped by God? WOW

“They that wait upon the Lord

They shall renew their strength, = if your ever weak

They shall mount up with wings like eagles, = when problems get too big

They shall run and not be weary, = don't have to ever lose a step

They shall walk and not faint = the devil can't touch you

Today I want you to know that God is never late.

- ◆ Perhaps you remember the story of a man name Lazarus who was dead for four days and everyone thought that is was too late for Jesus to do anything but nevertheless Jesus surprises them all by saying He is the resurrection and life, he who believes in me, though he may die, he shall live. Therefore Jesus walked up to the tomb (knowing himself and Father with absolute certainty) and told death to loose Lazarus and for Lazarus to come forth and live again.
- ◆ Perhaps you remember the time a man name Jairus came running unto Jesus and fell at his feet, earnestly begging him to come to his house that Jesus may healed his daughter for she is at the point of death. You know the story; a woman with an issue of blood who touched the hem of his garment interrupts Jesus. After Jesus

speaks his final words to the woman and proceeds to go to Jairus house, people from Jairus house comes and tells him that it is too late. The girl is already dead. There is no need for the Master to come anymore for it is too late for anything to be done. Nevertheless Jesus shows up to the house and says to the little girl arise. Proving to everyone that it is impossible for God to be late.

- ◆ Perhaps you even remember the story of the time when God told Abraham to sacrifice his only son Isaac who was the promise and chosen child. Therefore Abraham being obedient to God proceeded to do thus but God stopped him and provided an alternative sacrifice.
 - ◆ Perhaps many of you remember the exodus story when Moses was leading the nation of Israel out of the land of Egypt but then they encountered an opposition known as a sea. Hence God proceeds to part the waters so that they could walk across on dry ground and away from Pharaoh's harm.
 - ◆ Perhaps you remember the time in your own life when you were down out and didn't know how you were going to make it but somehow God stepped in and took control over the situation so that it worked out in your favor. Do I have a witness in this place?

Every time we feel or think that someone is late (especially someone who we are dependent upon or relying on) **fear, doubt, and worry**, begins to creep in.

- ◆ We are **afraid** that the situations won't get any better.
- ◆ We **doubt** if this person who we feel is late is really true or not.
- ◆ We begin to look at all the things that are against us instead of trusting in God thus **worry** sets in.

Today in the name of Jesus Christ I rebuke all fear, doubt, and worry. I pray that it will no longer have a hold or place in your mind any longer. Today I pray that you know forever, that is impossible for your God to be late. In Jesus Christ name Amen!

4 reasons as to why it is impossible for God to be late.

1. He's always mindful of me. He never forgets, neither does He ever stop thinking about me. (Ps. 8:4)
2. He never leaves me lonely. He promises to be with me always, through thick and thin, and through the good times as well the bad.
3. He always makes a way out of no way.
4. He arranges things in such a way that they work out for my good. Do not the Scripture say, "all things are working for the good of those who love the Lord?"
5. He knows what things I am already in need of before I do.
